- IFAPAC amplifies NAIFA's advocacy voice in Washington, D.C., and every state capital.

Membership

Recruit at least three members to NAIFA during your membership tenure. (You can always recruit more and receive additional accolades). Or, you can qualify by graduating from the Leadership in Life Institute (LILI) program.

Grassroots

Hold the Financial Security Advocate badge. Complete the self-paced course (approximately 2 hours) or attend one of our scheduled academies in 2024 to earn the badge in real-time. You only need to earn the badge once--there is no renewal needed; however, we would love to applaud you by attending your State Legislative Day and/or Congressional Conference each year.

IFAPAC

To qualify for Triangle Team, you need to be a current contributor to IFAPAC which means that you have contributed in the last 12 months. There is no set amount or level you must contribute. This criterion focuses on your active engagement with IFAPAC and is an additional accolade to other IFAPAC reward and recognition levels.
