

Rear Admiral (two stars) Ted LeClair is the Managing Director of Saltwater Leadership (SWL). In this role, he spearheads SWL's programs on building leaders. Previously he served as the Deputy Commander for U.S. 7th Fleet. At any given time, there were 70-80 ships and submarines, 140 aircraft and approximately 40,000 Sailors and Marines in the Fleet. It's Area of Responsibility (AOR) encompasses more than 48 million square miles from the Kuril Islands in the north to the Antarctic in the south, and from the International Date Line to the 68th meridian east, which runs down from the India-Pakistan border (think Hollywood to Bollywood).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Villanova University, and master's degrees from the Harvard Kennedy School and the US Army War College. He also is a graduate with distinction from the Joint Forces staff college. He is a Kolbe Certified consultant.
